Submission requirements

Required elements of the abstract manuscript:

- UDC identifier (Times New Roman, 12, semi bold);
- TITLE ((Times New Roman, 14, upper-case, center alignment, semi bold);
- authors' last names (Times New Roman, 12);
- name and address of the organization (Times New Roman, 12);
- *E-mail* (Times New Roman, 12, italic);
- abstracts body text (Times New Roman, 12);
- conclusions (Times New Roman, 12);
- reference list (according to the requirements of state standard 7.1: 2006) (Times New Roman, 12, italic);

Manuscript language: abstracts are provided in Ukrainian, Russian or English and published in the original language.

Format of the abstract manuscript: abstracts are provided in a file format doc (docx) through downloading your profile on the conference website or e-mail it to ittrends.forum@gmail.com.

Body text must be Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1 word spacing, standard letter spacing, borders - 20mm.

Tables are in Excel or Word without filling; formulas and expressions are realized in MS Equation.

Figures and drawings in Word must be grouped and represent a single graphic object. All illustrations must be submitted in black and white or gray gradation.

Abstracts size is at least 1 full page and no more than 2 full pages of A4 format.

List of references is limited to three sources.

Abstracts that do not meet the requirements will not be published in the online book.
